

# Troop Leader Learning Progression

## Step 2: Begin Training

### Step 1: Register as a Troop Leader

- Register as a Girl Scout Volunteer at GSSNE.org \*
- Submit to Background Screening(s) \* NBC plus [CORI](#) for MA (you'll receive an email from STERLING Volunteers)

- Read the Volunteer Essentials \* (G)
- Sign Volunteer Essentials Attestation form \* (G)
- Complete Troop Finance Training \* (G)

*Typically completed in 30-60 minutes but MUST be completed within 30 days of being assigned*

## Step 3: Complete Paperwork

- Ensure your co-leader completed all training requirements
- Request Troop Number Activation if yours is a new troop (F)
- Submit Troop Information Update Form \* (F)
- Request permission to Open a Troop Bank Account \* (F)
- Register the Bank Account \* (F)

## Step 4: Build Your Troop

- Connect with your Service Unit (I)
- Meet with your co-leader to plan the year
- Plan and host your caregiver meeting \* (I)
- Plan and host your first troop meeting \* (I)
